#### WEBINAR ON STRESS MANAGEMENT








#### WEBINAR ON BUSINESS ANALYSIS

## WORKSHOP ON FULL STACK DEVELOPMENT-ANGULAR JS

A workshop on the topic "Full Stack Development-Angular JS" was organized at Banarsidas Chandiwala Institute of Information Technology, New Delhi on 4<sup>th</sup> June 2022. The speaker of the day was our alumni Mr. Shubham Patel. It was a very informative session.

The speaker overviewed that a full stack web developer has the ability to design complete web applications and websites. They work on the frontend, backend, database and debugging of web applications or websites. He continued the session with introduction to Angular JS and briefed about Angular. He elaborated that Angular JS is a JavaScript open-source front-end framework that is mainly used to develop single page web applications. He said that it is a continuously growing and expanding framework which provides better ways for developing web applications. The students enjoyed the session as it also gave a hands-on practice to the contents.


### **ALUMNI INTERACTION SESSIONS**




#### PRE-PLACEMENT TRAINING SESSIONS

Ms. Bharti Sijwali (Karate Brown Belt trained from Indian Tibetan Border Police) and Ms. PriyankaYadav (Green Belt trained from Delhi Police Academy) were appointed as professional trainers for this intricate 10-day Self Defense Programme.






# A VISIT TO NATIONAL SCIENCE CENTER






#### **BLOOD DONATION CAMP**
