- It makes us feel more comfortable with each other and encourages even more healthy and effective communication.




- **4.) Swot analysis** was done at BCIIT, to make students realize their potential.

7.) The Role play activity was also organized with the students at BCIIT, they were given many roles to play, For example going to a restaurant, or Banks, playing the role of customers as well.





Language Lab / Workshop




