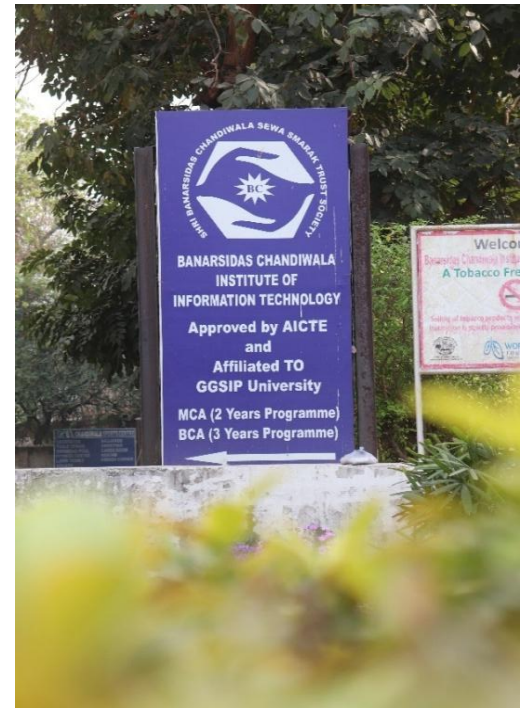

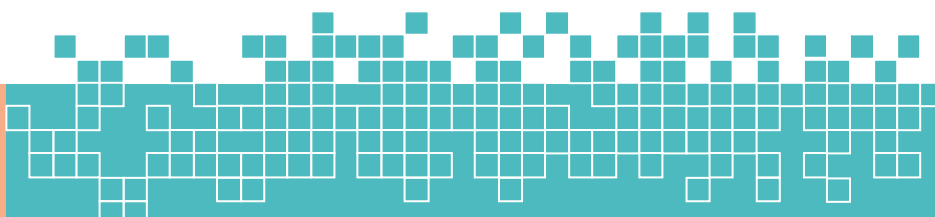

The winners were awarded ₹2,500 cash prizes, trophies, and exclusive Boat Goodie Sets, celebrating their dedication, innovation, and hard work.

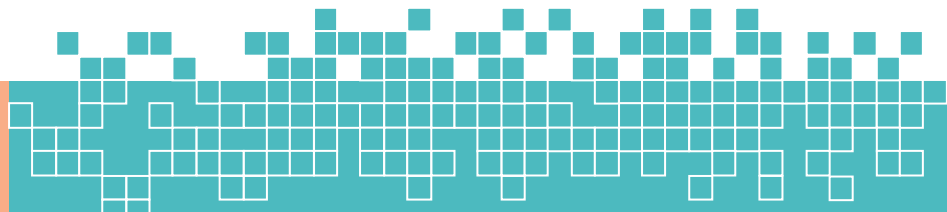
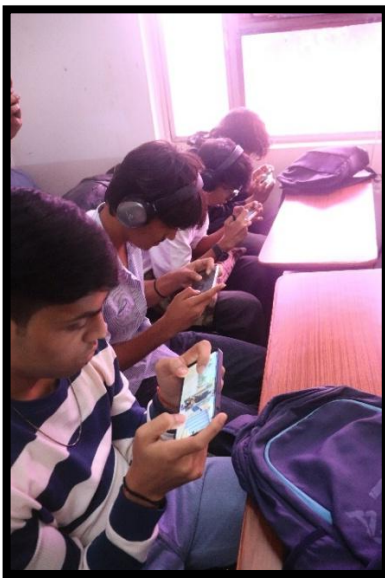

काव्यांजलि (Kavyanjali) – Poetry Competition on Sadbhavana Diwas

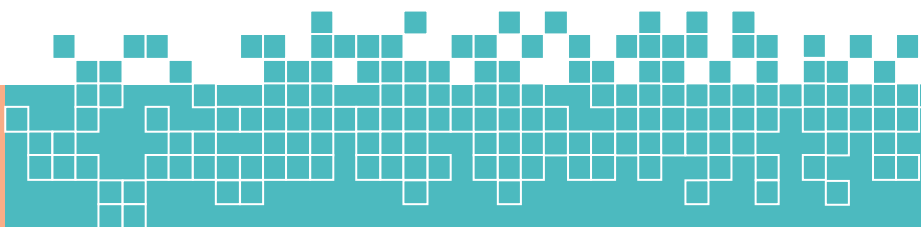

Blood Donation Drive at BCIT

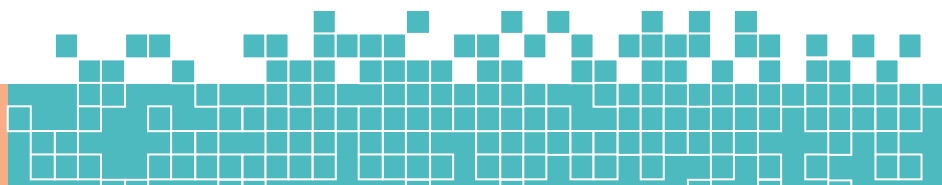

Internal Hackathon 2025 (Under Smart India Hackathon – SIH)

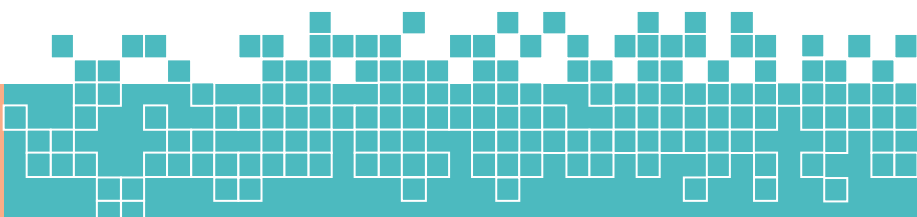

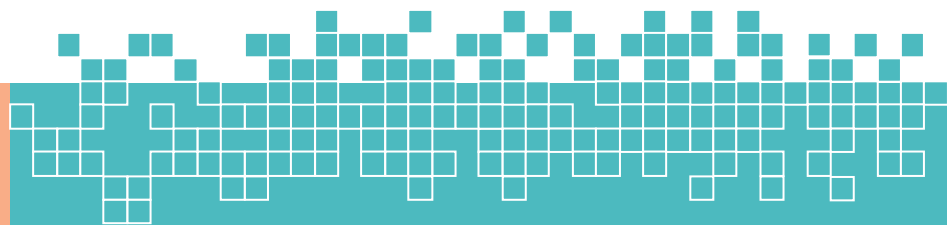
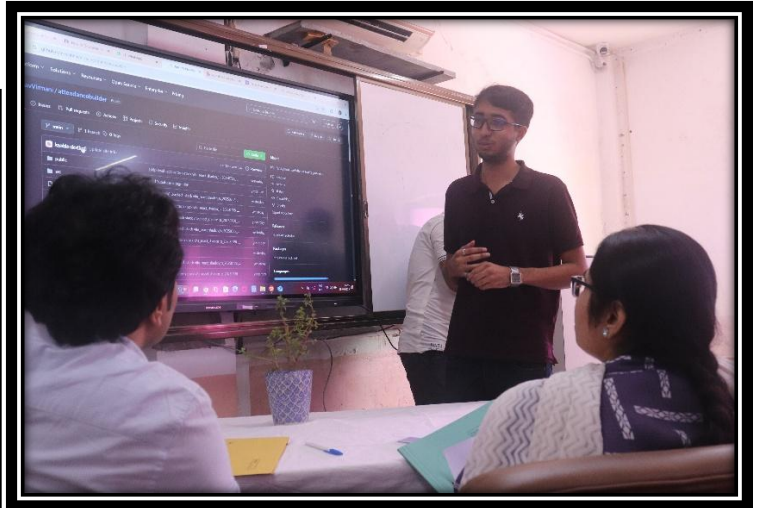
Highlights of Internal Hackathon 2025:

“Why Wait, Create: Your Career As A Tech Founder”

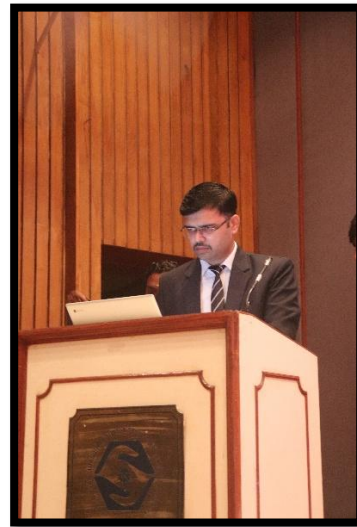

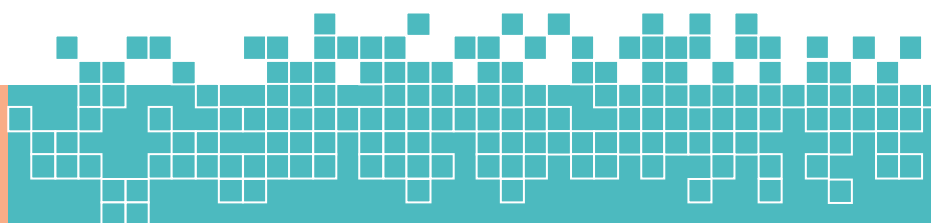

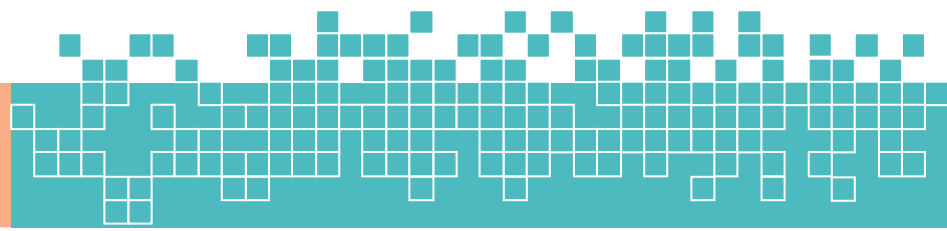
Among the highlights, the volleyball team delivered a commendable performance by advancing to the third round, showcasing determination, skill, and resilience against strong competition.
