Beginner-Friendly Approach – The session was designed for all skill levels, making it accessible and easy to understand.




Pledge-Taking Ceremony for Delhi Elections 2025



The objective of the event was to encourage students to participate in the democratic process and cast their votes in the upcoming Delhi Elections scheduled for 5th February 2025.




Date: 7th March 2025


After an intense and inspiring competition, the winners were announced as follows:







- Business planning and risk management




The interactive session provided students with a platform to understand entrepreneurship as a viable career option. Some of the key takeaways from the event included:

Our students continue to shine in the realm of sports, making the institution proud with their dedication and hard work.






Styling Sensation – Drishti (BCA)



Solo Song Performances by Mridang Music Society:



Expert Sessions













MOCK- INTERVIEWS




